Mr. Attorney General,

As part of that election process, it is required that elective candidates subscribe to certain statutory oaths on separate occasions. Unfortunately, one of those oaths stats that the candidate is not the holder of any monies owed to the State of Georgia.

It has come to my attention the District Attorney of Fulton County, Georgia, Fani Willis, is the holder of \$250.00 in late fees due, billed, and payable to the State Ethics Commission (formerly Georgia Government Transparency and Campaign Finance Commission) from as far back as 2018.

Prior to and after her election to that office she subscribed to various oaths, and on at least two occasions, she swore that she was not the holder of any unaccounted-for public funds. Her failure over these years to remit said funds in a timely manner has raised a presumption of violations of several Georgia Criminal Statutes, e.g.:

OCGA § 16-8-2, OCGA § 16-10-1, OCGA § 16-10-20, and OCGA §16-10-71

I am requesting that you initiate an immediate inquiry into the provable facts and evidence hereof, and upon obtaining such, that you commence an immediate prosecution of this matter.

Herein, take due notice and govern yourself accordingly.
